**Sub:** Permission to Jaipur National University Institute for Medical Sciences and Research Centre in the ongoing process for admission of students against 150 seats in third batch of MBBS course for the academic year 2018-19.

Sir,

With reference to the subject cited above, undersigned is directed to bring in to your notice, the judgement of the Hon'ble High Court dated 17-07-2018 which says that "In our considered opinion, Article 226 is supervisors jurisdiction though not akin to the powers of Supreme Court but in our exercise of powers, we set aside the orders of the MCI dated 28<sup>th</sup> March 2018 which was confirmed by the Central Government vide order dated 1<sup>st</sup> May 2018 granting the petitioner -College recognition which was kept under abeyance because of the interim order granted by the Supreme Court. Therefore now abeyance order will come to an end and recognition granted by the Central Government on 31<sup>st</sup> May 2018 will revive and other consequential orders of consideration of the petitioner college for the admission of third batch of students which is under progress will be considered by the competent authority." It is directed further that "In that view of the matter, the decision of the MCI dated 28<sup>th</sup> March 2018 and Central Government vide order dated 1<sup>st</sup> May 2018 both are quashed and set aside"

In view of the above, the State Government has taken a decision to allow the Jaipur National University Institute for Medical Sciences and Research Centre to participate in the counselling which is under process, for admission of students against 150 seats in third batch of MBBS course for the academic year 2018-19 subject to the directions of Hon'ble Supreme Court in case GOI or MCI files appeal in Apex Court against orders of Hon'ble High Court.
